

Ontario Development Code

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Introduction

The following two sections, Zoning and Land Use Regulations and Subdivision Regulations, constitute the Ontario Development Code.

This Code has been adopted by the Ontario City Council for the purpose of establishing legally binding yet easy to understand rules and regulations for the development and redevelopment of land in Ontario as well as for the subdivision of existing lands.

In addition to specific regulations, Section I, Zoning and Land Use Regulations, contain recommended Design Guidelines for the development of various types of land uses in the community. These represent preferred ways of implementing standards of the Development Code and General Plan in a manner that will comply with all of the provisions of these documents as well as resulting in quality development.
