## **Descriptive Summary**

Bliss Brown Collection 1900-1975

### **Creator**

This collection was donated to the Library on March 7, 2006 by Library Board president Ruby Leavitt.

### **Extent**

### **Abstract**

Bliss Brown was a longtime Ontario fixture. He was born in the late 1800's or early 1900's and died Feb. 1977. He came to the attention of Wayne Leavitt, Ruby's husband when he was asked to administer Mr. Brown's estate. This estate consisted of a 5 acre parcel on Taylor St. near the Sunkist laboratory. It was covered with junk as Mr. Brown was a junk dealer. In 1975, through the combined efforts of the Ontario Fire and Code Enforcement Departments and the Ontario Kiwanis club, Mr. Brown's junk was sold/disposed of and his property was exchanged for a similar parcel in Fontana. He was moved to that property and apparently died 2 years later, leaving no heirs. The Leavitts decided to donate the following items to the Model Colony Room.
