Howard A. "Jerry" Cramer was born in 1892 in Fulton, Michigan. In 1921, he moved to Ontario and worked for and retired from General Electric. He was an avid photographer and past president of the Euclid Avenue Camera Club. He died at the age of 93 on February 20, 1985. Two years later, his wife Nina donated this collection of photo essays to the Model Colony Room.
