The DAR, a genealogical society founded in 1890, promotes patriotism and children's education. The San Antonio chapter of the California region was founded in the early 1900's. This collection consists of scrapbooks, yearbooks, photos, minutes and other items pertaining to this chapter from 1915 to 1993.
