Water Conservation Tips

- Use a broom instead of a hose to clean sidewalks, driveways, and other paved areas.
- Wash your car using a hose equipped with a shutoff nozzle, or at a commercial car wash which recycles water.
- Use decorative fountains which recycle water.
- Encourage restaurants to serve water only to those who request it.
- Promptly repair plumbing leaks.
- Water landscape no more than every other day and during the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
- Adjust sprinklers to avoid runoff onto sidewalks and streets.
